Force 911 to Exhibit a Hybrid Propane Police Vehicle at the Enforcement Expo Southeast

Pendergrass, Georgia, October 22, 2009 – Force 911, a law enforcement vehicle outfitter located in Northeast Georgia, will exhibit at the Enforcement Expo Southeast, October 28 – 30, 2009, located at the Georgia World Congress Center in Atlanta, Georgia. As part of the exhibit, Force 911 will display a Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptor that has been converted to a hybrid propane fuel vehicle. The propane demo vehicle will showcase the Prins components which features a Vapor Sequential Injection (VSI) system. The vehicle will also display a standard propane fuel tank mounted in the trunk of the Police Interceptor. Representatives from Force 911 will be on hand to answer any technical questions regarding the hybrid propane fuel system.

According to Wayne Abbs, President of Force 911, “We find that one of the most important factors to educating law enforcement agencies about the technology is to show them the hybrid propane fuel system installed in a vehicle. The Enforcement Expo is the perfect venue for law enforcement agencies to get a first hand view of the components that make up our hybrid propane vehicle conversion. Abbs added, “Not only do hybrid propane fuel conversions reduce fuel expense, the units can be removed and reused in EPA approved vehicles as law enforcement agencies update their fleet. This technology is flexible and can adapt and grow with the department’s future fleet needs.”
